6. National Children's Science Congress

: 27th to 31st December, 2012

7. Indian Science Congress

: 3rd to 7th January, 2013

8. Kerala Science Congress

: 29th January to 1st February, 2013

The gifted children undergoing promotion of excellence programme of the Department of Education will also be associated with the National Children's Science Congress Project preparation and present their work at the District level Children's Science Congress.

It is informed that all the District Co-ordinators of National Green Corps Programme and Secretaries of Science Clubs at District level are respectively identified as the District Co-ordinators and District Academic Co-ordinators of National Children's Science Congress in Kerala. They are expected to participate in the State level workshop proposed to be conducted at Sasthra Bhavan, Thiruvananthapuram on 20th September, 2012.
